
Clean Up Day 2024

On Saturday, May 18, 2024, the Rogers Public Works Department will hold a Clean Up Day at the Rogers Public Works Building, 22350 South Diamond Lake Road (West of Kohl's), from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. This service is available for Rogers residents only. Contractors must find alternative services.

Attendees are asked to stay in their vehicles unless they need to get out to open a hatch/trailer, etc.

For the fastest and easiest service, please load and arrange items in the following order, beginning at the front of your trailer by the tongue/hitch or nearest the cab of your truck: (1st) scrap metal/tires/bikes; (2nd) oil/antifreeze; (3rd) recycling; (4th) batteries (no household alkaline or lithium batteries accepted); (5th) furniture; (6th) appliances; (7th) mixed solid waste/demo debris; (8th) electronics/light bulbs.

(Electronics/light bulbs will be unloaded first and scrap metal/tires/bikes will be unloaded last.)



Appliances

(White Goods) are \$15 each. Appliances such as:

- Refrigerators
- Freezers
- Washers
- Dryers
- Dishwashers
- Garbage Disposals
- Microwaves
- Dehumidifiers
- Trash Compactors
- Furnaces
- Water Heaters
- Stoves
- Space Heaters

Note: No RV or Ammonia Refrigerators

Commercial Appliances, \$25 each

<u>Tires (with or without rims)</u>

- Automobile Tires, \$3 each
- Light Truck Tires, \$3 each
- Semi-Truck Tires, \$10 each
- Tractor Tires, \$30 each

Electronics

- Computers/Monitors and TVs 25" and smaller, \$25 each
- Computers/Monitors and TVs larger than 25", \$35 each
- All other electronics are \$5 each

Miscellaneous items

- Water Softeners/Air Conditioners \$20 each
- LP Tank (up to 20 pounds), \$5 each
- Misc. Solid Waste & Demo Debris per cubic yard, \$40
- Hide-a-bed, \$50 each
- Couch, Chair or Love Seat, \$35 each
- Mattress or Box Spring, \$35 each

Also Accepted at No Charge

- Newspapers
- Tin/Steel/Aluminum
- Grills (tanks must be empty)
- Plastic Bottles with Necks
- Phone Books
- Glass Bottles (unbroken)
- Lead Acid Batteries (i.e. car batteries)
- Fluorescent Bulbs
 - *Limit 25 bulbs per household
 - *No Commercial Recycling
- Drain Oil
- Anti-Freeze
- Oil Filters

Items Not Accepted

- No printers, copiers or fax machines
- No household hazardous waste

- No household food or organics
- No paint or yard waste
- No household batteries (i.e. alkaline or lithium batteries)
- No exercise equipment
- No RV or ammonia refrigerators

The City of Rogers Public Works Department will be making special curbside pickups for the elderly and residents with disabilities. To arrange for this service, please call the Public Works Department at (763)-428-8580, Ext. 208, on or before Friday, May 10, 2024. You will need to have your items placed curbside by 7:00 a.m. on Monday, May 13, 2024. Staff will not be able to assist with getting the items to the curb. There will be no refunds if someone other than City Staff removes items from the curb prior to pick up. Cash and credit cards accepted.
