Neighborhood Watch Letter

December 11, 2023

Incidents from November 24, 2022 through December 8, 2023

- **November 25 at 1344 hours**, Officer took a theft report in the 22000 block of Wood Lane. Victim's personal items were taken from his residents by a known male party.
- **November 26 at 1819 hours**, Officers were dispatched to four theft from auto reports in the 20400 block of County Road 81. A window was smashed out of each vehicle and personal property was taken from each vehicle that was left in plain sight.
- **November 27 at 2115 hours**, Officer took a theft by swindle report in the 21300 block of Rogers Drive. Business was scammed into taking all cash on hand and depositing it into a bitcoin machine, then transferring it to the scammers account.
- **November 29 at 0715 hours**, while patrolling Officer observed a vehicle fail to stop for a school bus stop arm while children were on the street entering the bus. Officer identified and advised the driver on her driving conduct. Charges are currently pending.
- **November 30 at 1438 hours**, Officer took a report of a fraudulent unemployment filing.
- **November 30 at 1544 hours**, Officer took a report in the 13400 block of Rogers Drive concerning counterfeit money business received during a transaction.
- **December 1 at 1350 hours**, Officer took a past action theft report from business in the 20200 block of Rogers Drive. Two male suspects took over \$500 in unpaid merchandise.
