The City of Rogers is a lively and rapidly developing suburban community located west of Minneapolis. Still, with a current population of approximately 14,000, the city has maintained its small town feel. With its unique location at the intersection of two regional roadway systems - Interstate 94 (I-94) and Trunk Highway 101 (TH 101) - Rogers has become a major distribution center and a popular destination for businesses. Rogers also has a thriving employment base with over 11,000 jobs in a growing market. PARKS

Within a total of 2,579 Acres (2020), the City of Rogers consists of plenty of wide-open spaces. Specifically, 452 acres of park land, 14 playgrounds, the Senior Center, the Community Room, the Activity Center, over 20 multipurpose play fields, 17 baseball/softball fields, and 35.9 miles of trails, paths, and sidewalks.

SHOPPING & DINING



20+ NUMBER OF DINING OPTIONS IN ROGERS






FREEWAY ACCESS TO MAJOR HIGHWAYS Interstate 94(I-94) and Trunk Highway (TH 101)
